General Business

- 1. How to cover RSS' recurring losses (Guy)?
 - Robin—fundraising. Serious fundraising hasn't happened for a couple of years.
 Hard to apply for grant money, as you can get funds for events, but not for coaches.
 - ii) Sonnie—need to get the coach to athlete ratios correct in order to run economically.- Very important.



- iii) Robin— increasing numbers by getting new parents into RSS—the Taster programme has been really good for this (biggest uptake of new parents from this). Flyers and Warriors come through to this programme.
- iv) Why are jackets necessary in light of Alpine's recurring losses (Adrienne)? Robin—Part of our subconcession with RAL is that the kids be identifiable as RSS kids on the mountain.
- 2. The point was made from a few parents that it is not clear to people where RSS fits into the bigger picture of training on the mountain. That needs to be made clearer. They said that the website does not spell that out to them, and there is a lack of information available to "new parents". Addressing this will help with our marketing, as they feel the word is not getting out.
- 3. Grant Stockman taking from our pool of athletes to set up his own programme has been damaging. Tyler suggested that we change from RSS being listed in all caps (online), in order to better differentiate ourselves from Stockman Sports.
- 4. It was suggested that a link to RSS on the Metservice website would be good.
